

Globalization Program

- International, Interdisciplinary and Intercultural opportunity for learning, teaching and research cooperation.
- Up to 50 places per year available for students from each university in the Globalization Program (€0 fees). 1st and 2nd semesters + Summer Sessions.
- One professor per semester from each partner university teaching 2 courses (or 2 professors teaching 1 course each) in the Globalization Program semesters.
- Scholarship opportunities include Residency-Excellence-Diversity (RED), Worldwide Mobility for Research Internships (WWM), Internships in Italy, and Erasmus+.

Globalization Program Grants & Scholarships

Worldwide Mobility for Research Internships

- 2-4 month period of research in a VIU member university or affiliated organization to develop master's or advanced undergraduate thesis
- supported by scholarships: € 700 € 2000 depending on destination

Internship Program

- Work experience in Italian companies, cultural and research organizations
- 2-4 months
- € 700 scholarship

Erasmus+ Mobility for Studies


- period of study at a VIU member university participating in the Erasmus programme (students of Italian universities only – travelling to non-Italian universities)
- •2-6 months
- € 250-€300 monthly grant for EU destinations
- •€750 monthly grant + travel for extra-EU destinations

RED Scholars (Residency – Excellence – Diversity)

- Awarded to talented students to contribute to the cost of living in Venice for a semester. Students may choose to spend it on the accommodation that best suits their needs.
- •Selected students participate in the organization of the plenary workshop, and an editorial project with viucommunity.org
- •€ 1625 per semester

Who is it for?


students enrolled in any Master's degree (including Laurea Magistrale) at one of VIU member universities who intend pursuing research for their Master's thesis in themes related to the Globalization Program students enrolled in their third or final year in a 4-year bachelor degree at one of VIU's member universities, who intend undertaking a final research thesis/project for credit in themes related to the Globalization Program



2-4 months € 700 - €2000 scholarship

When?

- Participation in a Globalizaton Program semester - minimum of 2 courses
- Research internships in the Worldwide Mobility program are from two to four months. Start and end dates of the mobility are fixed in collaboration with the host organization.
- They are usually completed by the end of the solar year (December 2023 for 2nd semester 2022-23 students).

During the semester applicants:

- Submit an intermediate draft proposal of their research project by April 2, 2023
- Submit a final research project proposal by May 14, 2023
- Attend group and individual meetings to get feedback on their research project proposal
- Participate in co-curricular activities



Criteria for Selection:

- Research project: 60%
- Mid-term evaluation in GP courses: 30%
- Participation in Co-curricular activities: 10%



Final Requirements:

- the selected candidate(s) must complete a minimum of two VIU courses obtaining a final grade average of 85/100 calculated on the basis of the best two.
- must participate in a minimum of five cocurricular activities during the semester.
- must participate in scheduled individual and group meetings during the semester with VIU academic tutors.
- must still be registered in a degree program at the home university

2-4 months € 700 scholarship



All students attending a semester of the Globalization Program and who wish to do an internship in a host organization in Italy following the semester.



Eligibility:

- Students must be registered for the Second semester 2022-2023 of the Globalization Program, and taking **at least three courses**.
- Regular, active participation in the co-curricular program is expected and will be considered an advantage for selection.
- It is not possible for students to compete for scholarships both in Italy and Worldwide Mobility (separate calls for application).
- The internship must be undertaken while the intern is still **registered at the home university**.



Criteria for Selection:

- Quality of the candidate (40%): CV, motivation letter, interview and compatible language skills with host organizations.
- Academic performance (40%): Based on the mid-term evaluation
- Participation in co-curricular activities
 (20%): a minimum of five co-curricular activities



Students who have already been selected for the Worldwide Mobility will not be considered as eligible.

Requirements for confirmation of placement:

- Successful completion of a minimum of three courses at VIU
- The internship must be undertaken while the intern is still registered in a degree program at the home university.
- Acceptance by a host institution

The internship placement and scholarship are conditional on the host institution accepting the candidate.


Virtual Exchange | Intercultural Communication




