



Admission petitions: Sept. 8-10 (12 noon) The petition form will pop up on VIU website after registration closes





Housing

Students who applied for accommodation arranged through VIU will soon receive an update on the status of their request. The delay in the process is due to the high number of applications.

As soon as the allocation to the different apartments is completed, students will receive information by email on:

- flatmates and their contacts
- address of the apartment
- name and contact of the owner/real estate agent
- check-in procedure

In 2021 the city of Venice celebrates the 1600th anniversary since its foundation. VIU will offer a special edition of the co curricular program called "Meeting Venice"


