



4. Protocol and Practice for Covid-19 Risk Mitigation

#### Situation in Italy

- Vaccinations
   90% of population over 12 is vaccinated with at least one dose or has recovered from Covid
- EMA-approved vaccines
   Comirnaty (BioNTech and Pfizer)
   Nuvaxovid (Novavax)
   Spikevax (Moderna)
   Vaxzevria (AstraZeneca)
   COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen

#### 4. Protocol and Practice for Covid-19 Risk Mitigation

#### **Digital Covid Certificates**

- "Green Pass"
  - vaccinated with EMA-approved Covid vaccine
  - recovered from Covid in the past six months
  - received a negative Covid-19 test result
- "Super Green Pass"
  - completed vaccination cycle with an EMAapproved vaccine in the past 120 days
  - received a booster shot of an EMA-approved vaccine in the past 120 days (regardless of type of preliminary vaccine cycle)
  - recovered from COVID-19 in the past 120 days



#### 4. Protocol and Practice for Covid-19 Risk Mitigation

#### Digital Covid Certificates | Restrictions

- "Green Pass"
  - premises of universities (including all activities of Venice International University)
  - place of work, public and private sectors
  - shops
  - public offices (from February 1)
  - post offices and banks (from February 1)
- "Super Green Pass"
  - staff in universities (teaching and admin)
  - Over 50s in any place of work
  - public transport (+ FFP2 mask).
  - bars and restaurants, indoors and outdoors
  - museums, exhibitions, other cultural sites
  - theaters and cinemas, performances (+ FFP2 mask).
  - Hotels and B&Bs



4. Protocol and Practice for Covid-19 Risk Mitigation

#### Entering Italy:

From EU countries, Israel, Korea, UK, USA
 Passenger Locator Form
 Vaccination Certificate\*
 Negative Covid Test (48 hrs for antigen, 72 for PCR)

\*Not vaccinated = 5 day quarantine + Covid Test

- From China or Russian Federation 10-day quarantine Booster vaccine available in Italy VIU support for both

4. Protocol and Practice for Covid-19 Risk Mitigation

#### At VIU

- Co-responsibility Pact
- Covid-19 Testing before arrival on campus
- Social distancing on campus
- Staggered timetable
- Masks compulsory indoors, and currently outdoors

#### 4. Protocol and Practice for Covid-19 Risk Mitigation

- Full 15 weeks on campus
- Dual/Online teaching (+blended)
- 50% capacity in classroom
- In the classroom: masks, hand sanitizer, cleaning
- Virtual office hours
- Compulsory attendance allowances
- Co-curricular activities & Plenary events

As soon as the allocation to the different apartments is completed, students will receive information by email on:


- flatmates and their contacts
